She has suffered from depression and suicidal ideation her whole life, and since 2017, complex post traumatic stress disorder (C-PTSD). Holly is also autistic and has ADHD.

After a suicide attempt in 2018, Holly travelled to South America seeking alternative treatment at a traditional shamanic plant medicine retreat in Peru.

Holly's experiences were profound and life changing. After her ceremonies her nightmares had lessened significantly, suicidal ideation had disappeared, and she no longer felt scared and anxious.

After returning from Peru, Holly discovered art therapy. She is now an enthusiastic fluid artist and psychedelic therapy advocate, helping veterans and first responders access psychedelic therapy overseas and teaching the value of art therapy.

She lives in Queensland, Australia with her partner, Charles and puppy, Rufus.'





Mahnaz Karimi is a modern artist with two decades of successful experience in painting. She is an award-winning artist working in various fields of art including Abstract art, Installation art and Mixed Media. As a creative artist, her methods are unorthodox. Her interest to art was cultivated during her teenage years and further developed when she opted to take her Bachelor's degree in Graphics. She had mastered the skills and chemistry of her medium, to further develop the process and expand its boundaries.

Her artworks are primarily based upon pouring which means applying the paint by pouring rather than applying the paint with a brush. This sense of fluidity along with the unpredictable nature of resin gives her the opportunity to explore varied textures found in nature more realistically than any other medium.

She has managed to include varying artistic styles and have expressed her concerns through different styles and mediums. She believes that Art is her first means of expressing feelings, to show other aspects of nature and realities of life to the viewers, to highlight the beauties and ease the griefs and hardships. Design is her perspective toward special subjects and objects."

Mahnaz received the Bronze A' design Award 2020 in Arts, Crafts and Ready-Made Design Category in 2019-2020 period with her wall art design "Dandelion and Wishes" which was selected to be exhibited at Hebei International Industrial Design Week in China. She was ranked #131 among all designers who had competed in the Arts, Crafts Design Award in the last thirteen years . She has displayed her unique arts and designs in various shows and exhibitions including Index Dubai 2023 & 2022, World Art Dubai 2023, 2022 & 2021, Al Murabbaa Arts Festival 2022 and DIFC Art Nights 2023 & 2022.

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


FREELANCE ARTIST







I sold this painting to an artist friend of mine in Bangalore where I exhibited it at a gallery. My friend bought it as a gift for her niece who is a dancer herself.





While trying to stay afloat, her own captivity doesn't let her go the agony.





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
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

One could recognize her vivid (almost technicolor) palette and bold composition, often disguising a vulnerable rawness within the themes she chooses. Her work is a true reflection of herself.

"I am a self-taught artist of 29 years and former textile designer for printed and woven bath products. In 2020 I started painting and selling my work again. One achievement that reignited my passion for art was being accepted into the Exhibizone International "LOVE - 2021 Group Exhibition" which I ranked #1 out of 94 artworks from 85 artists. Since then I have devoted myself 100% to developing my art business. I am currently designing my website while I build a new body of work.

My current work includes two different types: stylized portraiture and mixed media-fiber art-assemblages. I experiment and employ a variety of media, including acrylic, gouache, oil, pencil, ink, broken and cut glass, fiber- yarn-textiles, found objects, assorted scraps and recycled materials.

My love of color and texture are obvious in my work, and my process ranges from loosely planned compositions on my tablet first, to spontaneous and intuitive labor- intensive pieces derived from highly emotive themes.



Living at baseline (to me personally) means to live with untreated mental illness, and therefore having limited coping skills to handle life's challenges.


